For many years, the school has been successfully active on the international stage. As a multi-award-winning eTwinning School, “Copernicus” takes part in numerous European projects in cooperation with peers from Spain, Italy, Portugal, Turkey, and many other countries. Projects such as “GrAInY TrAInY” and “Walls & Calls” help students enhance their linguistic, digital, and social competences while learning cooperation, tolerance, and responsibility

for the world around them.

Another key pillar of the school’s activity is the Erasmus+ programme, under which the school holds accreditation and regularly organises student and teacher exchanges. It offers a unique opportunity to discover new countries, cultures, and educational systems, while developing linguistic and intercultural skills. Projects such as “EuroSpot” and “Education4You” are not only about travelling – they are also about working together to tackle modern challenges, from ecology and entrepreneurship to new technologies and digital education.



In June 2024, the school hosted the international GALESS conference “Energy Transition”, during which young people from various countries discussed the future of energy, sustainable development, and responsibility for our planet. The event combined theory with practice – participants presented their ideas, took part in workshops, lectures, and field activities, showing that young people are active co-creators of the global dialogue about the future.



Preparations are already underway for the next edition of the conference, scheduled for late June and early July 2026. This time, participants from around the world will meet in Rybnik to reflect on the topic of minorities – their role, rights, cultural heritage, and place in modern society. The conference will serve as a space for

open dialogue. Students, teachers, and invited guests will discuss how to build a world based on mutual respect and understanding, where every voice matters.

“Kopernik” is a school that combines tradition with a vision of the future – a place where learning transcends borders. It is a community that believes knowledge, engagement, and cooperation can truly change the world.


Ancient History added to our GALESS Community!

Suzhou High School of Jiangsu Province: Where a Thousand Years of Learning Meets Tomorrow



Have you ever wondered what it feels like to walk through a thousand years of history, on the very ground where scholars have pursued knowledge, century after century, without interruption?

Welcome to Suzhou High School of Jiangsu Province, a living museum of learning and a vibrant scholarly community where every stone tells a story, and every story inspires the future. Where a Legacy of "Worldly Mind" Begins

Our story starts with a choice – a choice for community over personal gain. In the 11th century, the renowned statesman *Fan Zhongyan* acquired a piece of land in Suzhou famed for its excellent *feng shui*, promising prosperity for generations. Instead of building a family estate, he made a visionary decision: he donated the land to found a public school, believing that nurturing countless talents would benefit the nation far more than blessing a single family.

From this act was born our foundational spirit: "**Be the first to bear hardships, and the last to enjoy comforts.**" This ideal of social responsibility is carved into our identity. For nearly a millennium, education has never ceased on this hallowed ground, earning us the title "a living fossil of China's basic education." Walking our central axis, students literally tread over a timeline inlaid in the ground, connecting their steps with those of Song Dynasty scholars who entered the school a thousand years ago.

Our campus is a "scholarly garden," designed to inspire. Students pass through *the Gate of Wisdom and Virtue*, reminded that great achievements require both intellect (Zhi) and moral character (De). 

Our alumni network includes over 60 academicians of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and Engineering, as well as globally renowned pioneers like Nobel laureate in Physics **Tsung-Dao Lee**, **Dr. Xiaowei Zhuang**, a Howard Hughes Medical Institute investigator and MacArthur "Genius Grant" Fellow, and **Dr. Tianxi Cai**, who became a tenured professor at Harvard University at the age of 24.

Today, our students' development goal of "**lifelong autonomous learners**" prepares students to be these world-changers of tomorrow. We implement a holistic curriculum that blends the depth of the Chinese national curriculum with the international perspective, cultivating "**inquiring, knowledgeable, and caring**" global citizens.
